



## TETON COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #1 IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Under Wyoming law, your student is required to be properly immunized against certain vaccine-preventable diseases. Teton County School District #1 requires complete immunization records in order to attend school. If your child does not receive immunizations due to medical or religious reasons, there will be exemption forms available for you to complete.

In order that you might anticipate immunization needs of your student, the following is a list of required immunizations at this time:

5 DTaP (Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis) - at least one dose on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

4 Polio, at least one on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

3 Hepatitis B series

2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) - the first dose on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and a second dose at least one month after the first dose

**Secondary students only:** An adolescent Tdap (tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis) or Td (tetanus-diphtheria) is required for all 7<sup>th</sup> grade students and for all incoming 8<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grade students who have not received a booster during the previous 5 years.

**Please obtain an official immunization record from your health care provider, Teton County Public Health Nursing office (733-6401), or previous school and return or fax to your child's school.**
