SUMMER READING TIPS FOR PARENTS

- Set a good example by modeling reading.
- Take your children to the library regularly to ensure books are available at home.
- Make sure your children 6 or older have a library card.
- Sign-up your children for the library's summer reading program and help them succeed with their goals by finding time for their reading.
- Let your child choose what they want to read.
- Read together or promote reading for your children daily.
- Check out books on tape or magazines to add variety to literacy.
- During trips, encourage children to read aloud traffic signs, billboards, store fronts, etc.
- Encourage children to keep a summer scrapbook with writing and drawings.
- Make reading fun, relaxed and exciting.
